# Public Health Measures Applied through all Traffic Light Settings



## **Basic Hygiene**

Basic hygiene measures include good hand hygiene, cough, and sneeze etiquette, avoid touching your face, and regularly clean and disinfect surfaces.

Hand sanitiser will be at each entry point and children will be encouraged to sanitise hands as they enter and exit the classroom and before eating.



## **Vaccination**

Getting vaccinated is a key step to gain more protection against the virus.



# If you are sick - stay home and get tested

If you have cold, flu or COVID-19 symptoms, stay home.
Call your doctor or Healthline on 0800 358 5453 for advice about getting tested.
Staff will observe children on arrival, checking for symptoms.
Those presenting as unwell will be asked to go home.



#### Ventilation

Indoor spaces should be well ventilated.

All doors, windows and vents around the school need to be opened.

CO2 will be measured in all spaces to ensure safe working spaces.



## Case management across all Traffic Light Settings

If a child or staff member contracts COVID-19 they must isolate for 7 days. If your child is a household contact of someone that has contracted COVID-19 they also must isolate for 7 days. Please let the school know if this affects you. All children have been given Home Learning packs to work through if they are affected.

Closing schools on site is an unlikely option in all colours of the framework.

## Mask Wearing

Masks are strongly recommended for children in Year 4-6. Evidence from Term 1 shows that masks minimised the spread of COVID in classrooms.

All staff will continue to wear masks when indoors.

All visitors and adults must wear masks while onsite.

If there is evidence of spread in a classroom, all children (Y4-6) will be expected to wear a mask to minimise any further transmission.



## Ventilation

Indoor spaces should be well ventilated.

All doors, windows and vents around the school need to be opened. This will continue to happen throughout the winter months. Classrooms will be warmed before school using heat pumps (and during break times if required).

All staff and children must come prepared for colder weather, packing extra layers in case they are needed.

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	The school regularly monitors C02 levels in classrooms.
	More School activities are available for children in Term 2  Assemblies: -No whole school assemblies in the Hall at orangeNo Hui Time
School Activities	Kapahaka: Kapahaka will begin in Term 2.
	Fitness: continue outdoors.
	<b>School Trips:</b> Whanau groups can plan school trips for their tamariki or invite guests onsite.
	<b>Parent Helpers:</b> can resume but must be masked, symptom free and sign in on our school Vistab in the School Office.
	<b>Playball, Rhythm n Steps. Marzipan, and Music Education:</b> will all resume at Orange.
(Erk)	All surfaces, high touch points (door handles and light switches), devices, and shared classroom resources will be disinfected at the end of each day by the classroom teacher.
Cleaning Procedures	Classrooms and all shared spaces will be cleaned thoroughly by our contracted cleaners daily.
	Shared facilities (staffroom, photocopier) will be cleaned by the caretaking team daily.
	There is no requirement for physical distancing.
Physical Distancing	
•	Parents can now enter the school grounds at drop-off and pick-up times.
	We ask that visitors to the school, including parents and whānau, wear a mask whenever they are on school grounds.
Visitors	Please refrain from going into the classrooms during school hours. If you wish to meet with your child's teacher please make an appointment.
	All visitors helping in classrooms, please sign in using our school Vistab (tablet), situated in the main office (rainbow room).
Sign In Procedures	QR codes are located around the school if you choose to use them.
riocedures	Children and staff must stay at home if they are sight
	Children and staff must stay at home if they are sick.  Children or staff members with <u>COVID-19 symptoms</u> should get a COVID-19 test and remain at home until a negative result is received and they are symptom free

Stay home if sick and get tested	for 24 hours.  You may be requested to pick up your child from school if they are presenting with symptoms or are unwell.
Home Learning	"Schools are open for all children". We are expecting all children to return to school.  All children have been given a Home Learning Pack that can be used if they are isolating at home.
EOTC (Education Outside of the Classroom)	Camps will continue.  Sport tournaments and events will resume following health and safety guidelines  Class trips can resume.
